RESEARCH ASSIGNMENT

Marks: 100%

TASK: Choose a CD which is advertised as suitable for the 0 to 3 age group to help children sing in tune.

Analyse the contents of the CD to decide if you consider it suitable for the age group. Your analysis should consider the following:

- Are the songs/rhymes from the traditional repertoire.
- Are the songs a capella or is there an accompaniment.
- Is the accompaniment acoustic or electronic.
- What is the range of the songs. Is the range suitable for small children.
- Is there repetition for the children to begin to learn the material.
- Are the rhythms and beat secure
- Is the content **musical**.
- Would you recommend this CD to teachers and parents.

Present your findings in written form which to be handed in on the first day of the 2016 Summer Program. Also prepare an aural presentation to share your findings with the class. This should last for no more than 5 to 10 minutes and may include demonstrations from the CD. It will be presented during the second week of the class.

Criteria:

- Research and scholarship skills are evident and clearly presented.
- Information is chosen carefully and is relevant to the given task.
- The assignment is clearly presented with accurate grammar and spelling.
- An accurate bibliography, if necessary, is included.
- The aural presentation is clear, interesting and keeps to the given time.
